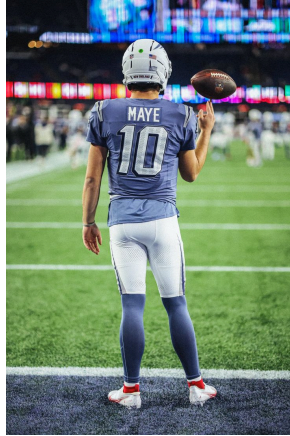


Pats to tha MF BOWL: Talking pats

We haven't played an offense/QB anywhere near the Seahawks level so far. I'm not saying our defense can't shut them down, but I am really skeptical that we can be DOMINANT like we have been these last 3 games.

- This means our offense is going to have to wake the fuck up if we're gonna win this game. Drake has played 3 elite defenses. I know. He has a terrorist calling plays at OC. I know. Campbell/Wilson have repeatedly turned into pumpkins in the postseason. I know. Despite all of this, Drake needs to find a fucking way to step up and let his fucking NUTS DRAG. I loved what he did with his legs in Denver. Now he needs to eliminate all of these misses he's having in the passing game that were automatic in the regular season. Looking beyond the Bowl

- This team has so many holes. I think we have a real chance to win it, but I hope that this run to the bowl doesn't leave the front office complacent in regards to getting aggressive in the draft and free agency. The first things that come to mind on the offensive side of the ball is getting a real offensive threat. Now I don't care if it's an explosive tight end (Hunter Henry is a guy but man he is on his way out) or a wide out but that is near the top of the list. Diggs has been great, and the supporting cast of Bouttem Douglas, Williams, and Henry have all had their moments but to continue the success of this year going into next year (against a much tougher schedule) we need to get at least one guy that is a legit gamebreaker. Outside of that on the offensive side of the ball, the offensive line COULD potentially be shuffled / changed a bit. Wilson and Campbell are both young, so I don't HATE letting this group rock, but I also can really get behind getting a legit left guard in the draft and moving Campbell to his real position of left tackle and getting him off the edge where he has had trouble at times.
- Defensively: Our secondary is fucking nice. Woodson, Hawkins, stepped up in such a big way this year. Marcus Jones is a fucking baller #hesdonemiraclesonme and is the heart and soul of this team. Gonzo is a fucking stud, and Davis is a fine #2. I'm not as crazy about him though, he had some big penalties in bad spots this year. I like our linebacking core, although Spillane is aging. Gibbens and Eliss are fucking dawgs tho I really like where that position group is at. This leaves us with what I think is the most pressing
