10: For the Low Pt. 2 - Lil Bibby Wiz Khalifa, Juicy J




6. Strawberry Swing - Frank Ocean

4. Sorry For the Wait - Lil Wayne





2. Intro - Rich the Kid, Famous Dex, Jay Critch


