Honorable Mention: Naomi Sharon

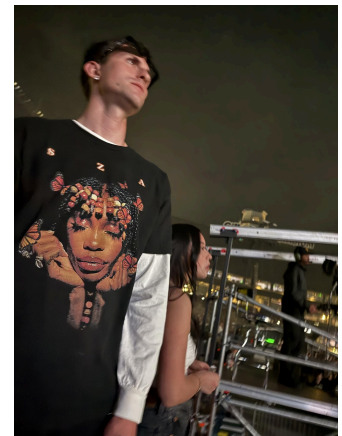
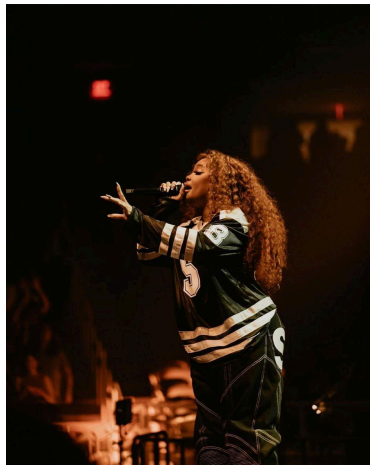

3: SZA:

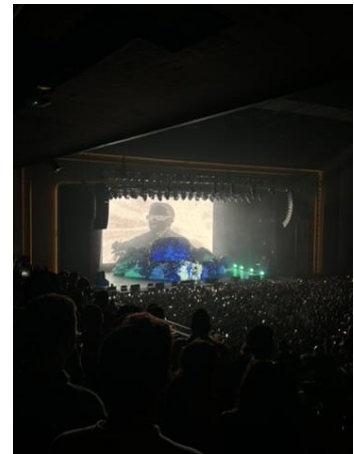
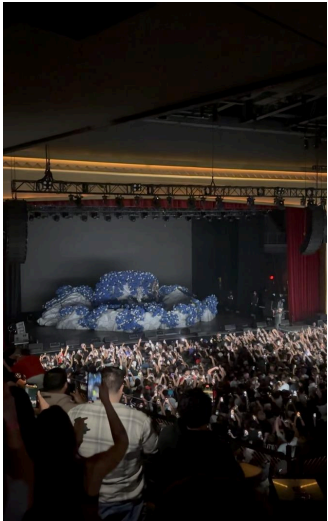

2: Gunna in Boston

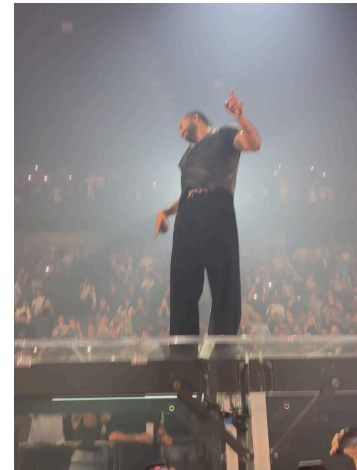
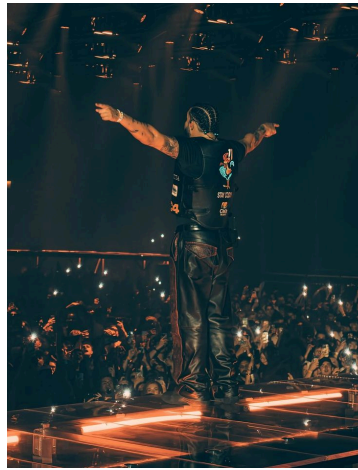
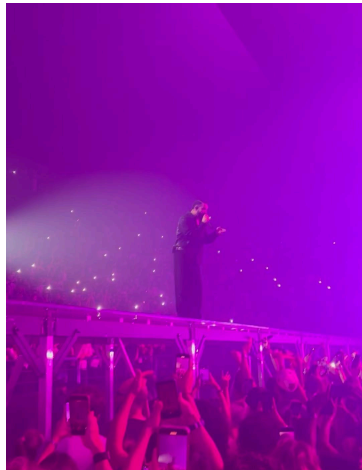
